The Old Red Museum's 4th floor's Great Hall and other rooms have been home to over 150 weddings, receptions and other events this past year.

The Old Red Museum of Dallas County History & Culture is located in the West End of downtown Dallas at 100 South Houston Street in the beautifully restored Old Red Courthouse built in 1892. Dedicated to inspire and educate visitors about the rich and varied cultural, economic, political and social history of the Dallas County area, the 2nd floor of Old Red is filled with interactive exhibits, 41 touch-screen computers, an educational learning center and four mini-theatres. The special exhibit gallery is located on the first floor. Admission to *The Civil War Through the Eyes of North Texans* is included in general admission. General admission is \$8, Children ages three to sixteen are \$5 and Seniors are \$6. Admission to the Civil War exhibit without general admission is \$3 for adults and \$1 for children.
